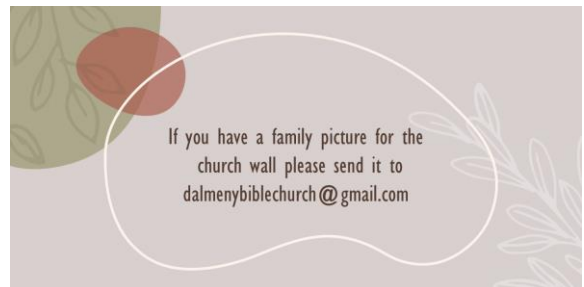
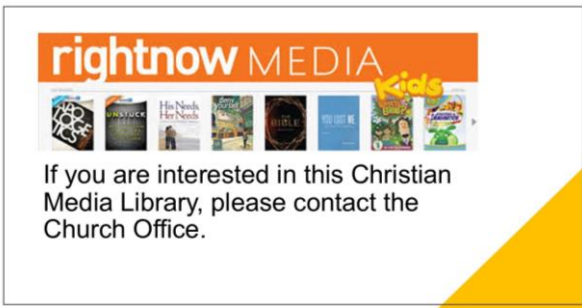
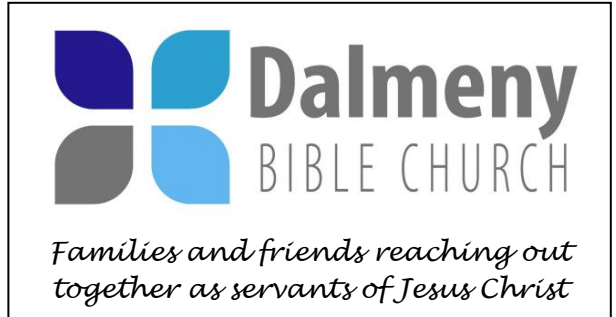

Have you ever wondered why we celebrate the New Year? It sort of seems like a strange holiday to me. Most holidays have some historical event to celebrate – Christmas and Easter being obvious examples. New Year's is more like, "Congratulations, the earth is a year older now than it was a year ago." I guess it's like a birthday party for the planet.

Clearly, the most exciting New Year's celebration ever was Y2K, when the calendar rolled from 1999 to 2000, and all the experts were declaring that society would collapse when computers couldn't handle the math.
