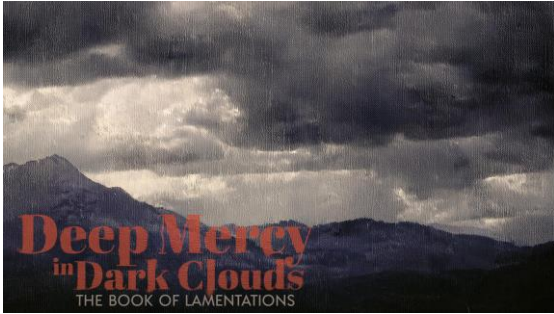



Camp Kadesh: There is only one week left to apply for our LIT program. The Leader in Training program is open to anyone finishing grade 9 this year or older. This program is the first step toward potentially being on staff at Camp Kadesh in future summers. Our three-week LIT program is designed to help young people grow in their faith, biblical knowledge, teamwork, leadership, and friendships. 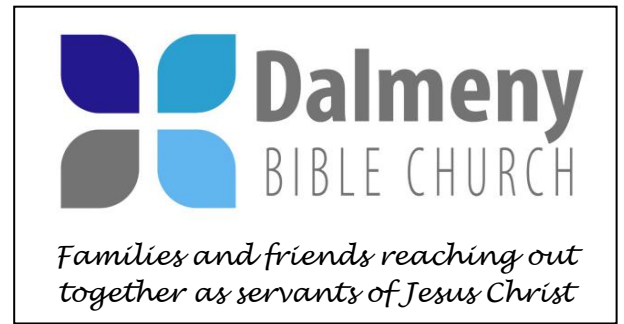

This time of year is very busy, somewhat tiring, and extremely encouraging for me. While the work can be tiring, the results are very energizing, and they remind me why this work is so important.

I have now enjoyed two of the three scheduled retreats for our pastors and their wives. I pray that the speaker and events we plan are encouraging, but I know that the most important aspect involves connections. Relationships with the other couples and with Gary and I are deepened, and couples in relationships with others know that ongoing prayer, encouragement, and advice are only a phone call or a personal visit away. This can be life-giving.

There is rest, relaxation and restoration for your pastor and his wife. There are learning opportunities and times of group discussion and prayer. But the key to these events is building connections that will positively impact the ministries of our pastors for years to come.

I also recently attended the annual winter meeting of the FEBC International Board of Directors. And they are acting not only with wisdom, but also with faith that God will accomplish what we cannot. I am grateful for each of them.
